Huntington disease (HD) is an inherited disorder that causes cells in specific parts of the brain to die. The HD gene is dominant, which means that each child born to a parent with HD has a 50% chance of sharing the same fate. This is the most devastating disease known to man. HD disrupts the brain which will take away a person's ability to think, speak, walk, run, make decisions and control one's body; memories become effectively locked-in because the brain can no longer access them.
